**8. Details of teachers' training:**

## **10. Efforts made in the field of environment education:**

1. Bhavans SL Public School organized an Environmental Education activity to promote awareness among students about the importance of plants and environmental conservation. The activity was conducted within the school premises with great enthusiasm and active participation from students of different classes.

The main objective of this activity was to instil a sense of responsibility towards nature and to help students understand the vital role plants play in sustaining life on Earth. Teachers guided the students about the importance of watering plants regularly, conserving water and maintaining greenery in their surroundings.

During the activity, students were taken to the school garden and different green areas of the campus. They were taught the correct method of watering plants, ensuring that water was not wasted. Students carefully watered flower plants, saplings, shrubs and potted plants. They also learned how excessive or insufficient watering can harm plants.

Teachers explained various environmental concepts such as the importance of trees in providing oxygen, maintaining ecological balance .

The Environmental Education activity proved to be highly informative and meaningful. It not only enhanced students' knowledge but also inspired them to become responsible and environmentally conscious citizens.

2. An awareness activity on "Say No to Plastic and Promote Jute Bags" was conducted in our school to make students aware of the harmful effects of plastic on the environment and to encourage the use of eco-friendly alternatives.

The activity began with explaining how plastic pollutes land and water and harms animals. Students were encouraged to reduce, reuse and recycle plastic items. They were also guided about the benefits of using jute bags, which are reusable, biodegradable and environment-friendly.

### 12. Innovations:

Innovative Teaching Learning Practice

\*Wing\* - Balvatika

\*Class\* - LKG

\*Topic\*- Colours

\*Objective\* - To help students strengthen their colour recognition skills using STEM approach, focussing on 21st century skills.

\*Pedagogy\*- Playbased , Experiential and Art integrated learning.

\*Requirements\*- Clear plastic jars, water, red,blue and yellow food colour, turmeric, detergent, lemon juice, droppers, paint brush, flower pot colouring sheet.

\*Methodology\*- In the academic session 2024-25, LKG adopted an activity based and hands on learning approach to strengthen the colour recognition skills of students. The methodology included a colour dress-up day, where students came dressed in their assigned colours. A special 'Magical Art session' was conducted where students added few drops of red, blue and yellow food colours in water, observing and naming the colours. Then they mixed two colours (eg. blue + yellow) and were amazed to see water turning green.They repeated the same process with different combination of colours to formulate new colours .

Secondly, another special activity combined Science and Art, where students did colouring on a flower pot colouring sheet with turmeric solution, added detergent to it and observed the colour change to brown. Afterwards, they added lemon juice to it, making the brown colour turn to yellow once again. Lastly students named the colours they observed in both activities.

\*Assessment\*- Students were asked to pick a colour and speak few lines on it.

This approach to teach the topic 'COLOURS' developed 4 C's in students i.e. \*Critical thinking\* through colour mixing activity, \*Creativity\* through colouring sheet activity, \*Collaboration\* by working cohesively with fellow mates and \*Communication\* through assessment work. It also blended \*Science\* ( mixing liquids, observing reactions), \*Technology\* (using droppers for measurement), \*Engineering\* (designing colour experiments) and \*Math\* (counting drops) into a colourful, magical art experience that made learning \*colours\* unforgettable for LKG students.

2. Innovations in diverse aspects in the field of Education is imbibed in the School Culture. Opportunities are provided to the students to develop 21st Century skills and entrepreneurial skills to make them future ready citizens.

All the students from Grade - 6 onwards are involved in Investigatory projects based on Design Thinking and STEM, where they develop Problem Solving Skills, Critical Thinking, Creativity, Resilience, team spirit. The finest of these Investigatory Projects and prototypes depicting the solutions to the local problems are then presented at different platforms at State and National Level such as VIKSIT Bharat, INSPIRE Award, National Children's Science Congress, CBSE Science Exhibitions, Bhavans Exhibitions. An Innovation Cell is established in the School, the incharges of

which make sure that the creative ideas of students get properly channelised and all the students remain motivated for the same.
